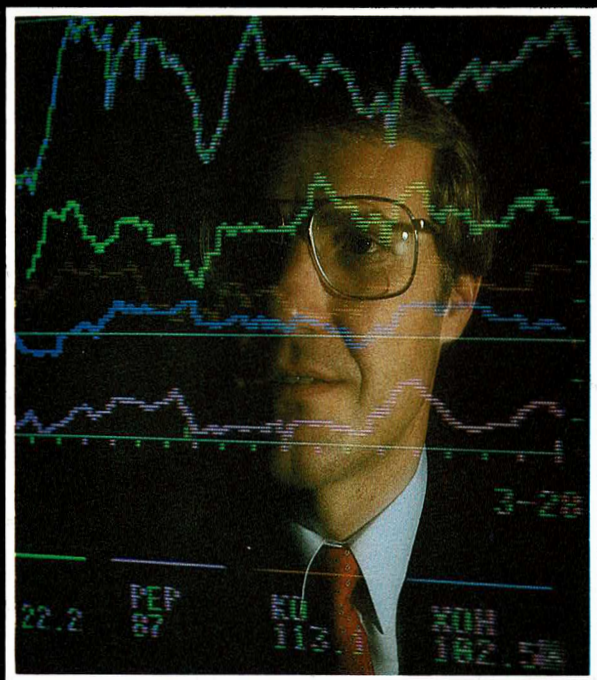

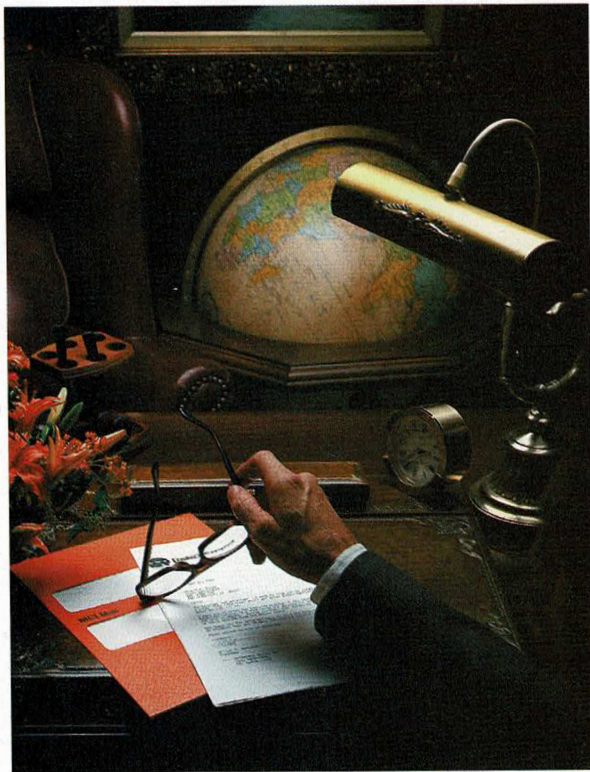

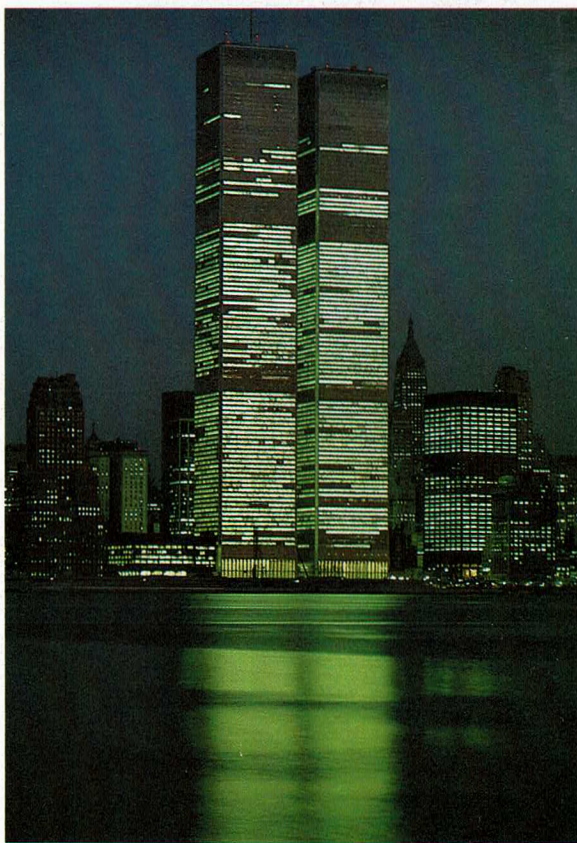

DOW JONES QUOTES

Current Quotes provides current information (with over a 15-minute delay) on stocks, options and corporate bonds, as well as current-day updates for U.S. Treasury issues, mutual funds, national OTC quotes, foreign bonds and government securities.

Historical Quotes indicates how a particular common or preferred stock has done during the past trading year. Users can call up daily, quarterly and monthly closing stock prices. Monthly summaries are available back to 1979; quarterly summaries back to 1978.

Historical Dow Jones Averages provides daily summaries of the transportation, industrials and utilities averages, and a composite of 65 stocks. High, low, close and volume are available for a full trading year.



FINANCIAL AND INVESTMENT SERVICES

Corporate Earnings Estimator provides consensus per-share earnings forecasts by analysts at over 60 major stock brokerage firms for 3,000 of the most widely-followed companies. Corporate Earnings Estimator offers investors information often available only to large institutions.
