Begin	CODE-B	Alt-B or CapsLock-B	Marks beginning of a selection of cells or text. (File, Plot, Write)

Duplicate	CODE-D	F4	Copies files, cells, or text to new location; leaves original in place. (File, Manager, Plan, Plot, Write)
Edit Sign- on Form	CODE-?	F1	Modifies Sign-on form used to access GRiD Central, or a file server device. (Manager)
Erase Cells	CODE-E	F8	Erases cells. Use the CODE-R or the CODE-C key to erase rows or columns. (File, Plan, Plot)
Erase Character	BACKSPACE	←	Erases character to the left of the cursor. (File, Plan, Plot, Write)
